Don and Marla will be visiting the states for their last home ministry assignment from March through August. They plan on retiring in December and relocating to the states. They ask for prayer: for their coworkers at the Lighthouse church who will be taking on more responsibility and especially Achilles who will be heading up the leadership; that God will raise up someone to take over the pastoral position when they leave; for some new believers to take the step of baptism and finally for safe travel, good meetings and finishing well in Taiwan.
